

Withdrawal/Transfer

Statistics.com has a flexible policy that recognizes circumstances may arise to prevent you from taking a course as planned. Please review the following information regarding cancellation/refund/transfer policies and student responsibilities:

Cancellation/Withdrawal from a Course:

Statistics.com does not cancel a course due to low enrollment.

Rejection: An applicant rejected by statistics.com is entitled to a refund of all monies paid

Five-Day Cancellation: An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within five days from date of registration, and **prior** to course start date is entitled to a refund of all monies paid.

Other Cancellations: An applicant requesting cancellation more than five (5) days after registration and tuition payment, and **prior** to the course start date, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, less the non-refundable registration fee of ₹ 3100/-.

Withdrawals on or after the first day of class are entitled to a refund of tuition (which does not include the non-refundable ₹ 3100/- registration fee) as follows:

Amount of Course Completed: Refundable Tuition due to Student

- 0-25% completed: 75% refund
- 25-50% completed: 50% refund
- 50-75% completed: 25% refund
- >= 75% of course: no refund

A student choosing to withdraw from a course may do so by completing and submitting an "Application for WITHDRAWAL from a statistics.com course." Please use [this form](#) to withdraw from a course. Transferring to Another Course:

You may transfer your registration to another course at any time prior to the **drop date**. The **drop date** for transfer from a course is midnight 12.00 IST on the Friday after the course start date (i.e. one week into the course). Transfer is not permitted after the **drop date**. The transfer fee is ₹ 800/- if you transfer prior to the start of the course, ₹ 3100/- fee to transfer once course begins up until the **drop date**.
